Format of Extended Abstracts

- Maximum four pages including references. Font :Times New Roman, single line spacing and font size:12
- Extended abstracts can contain figures, tables and/or images. Page format should be A4 page size with margins 2.5 cm wide from the right, left, top and bottom.

Extended Abstracts must be submitted along with the abstract, on or before 30th July to mineralsymposium2017@gmail.com

Extended abstract will be considered in the evaluation process of the abstract; hence the extended version must properly elaborate the abstract itself.
